

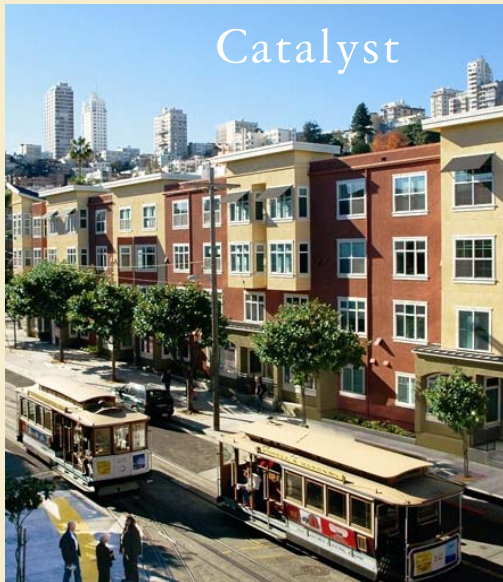

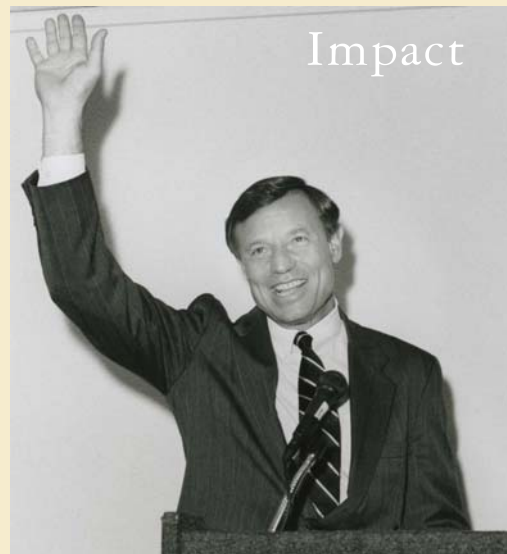
ABOUT THE RESIDENCY

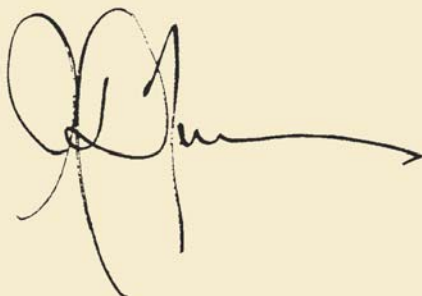
BRIDGE HOUSING
