

Marion and Wayland Cato Jr. Scholarship Application

Applicants will be undergraduate students attending the University of Wyoming either full-time or part-time who have demonstrated financial need.

Preference shown for students who 1) have worked for pay prior to their enrollment in the University and/or who are working for pay at the present time and 2) having worked without pay in some form of community service either prior to University enrollment or at the present time. Preference will also be given to transfer students from Sheridan College, with preference among those who have been Marion and Wayland H. Cato Jr. scholars at Sheridan College.

Successful applicants will complete a 500-word essay addressing the following questions:

1. Describe your educational goal and why it is meaningful to you;
2. Describe how you have paid for your education up to the present time;
3. State if you are a transfer student from Sheridan College;
4. Describe what type of community service have you have performed or participated in?

The number of scholarships will vary and amounts will vary. Recipients are eligible to renew this scholarship at UW based on academic progress and a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher. Students will need to apply for renewal through UW Student Financial Aid for subsequent years.

A selection committee composed of representatives of the University, and may include a representative of the donor, shall select the recipient(s) of the scholarship(s) based on the eligibility requirements.
